

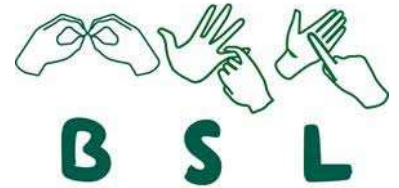
SANDY WOMEN'S INSTITUTE
